# **Acute Kidney Failure**

### CMS-HCC\_V28 Model Updates

This tip sheet is intended to assist providers and coding staff with the documentation and ICD-10-CM selection, along with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) Hierarchical Condition Category (HCC) Version 28 Model Updates, on services submitted to Healthfirst—specifically for Acute Kidney Failure. ### **ICD-10-CM Codes and Descriptions**

Under HCC V28 Model These Codes Will No Longer Risk Adjust For 2024 DOS		If documented and supported, providers may use other alternative ICD-10-CM codes, if applicable, such as:	
N17.0	Acute kidney failure with tubular necrosis	N18.30	Chronic kidney disease, stage 3 unspecified (moderate)
N17.1	Acute kidney failure with acute cortical necrosis	N18.31	Chronic kidney disease, stage 3a (moderate)
N17.2	Acute kidney failure with medullary necrosis	N18.32	Chronic kidney disease, stage 3b (moderate)

## **Documentation and Coding**

Under HCC V28 Model These Codes Will No Longer Risk Adjust For 2024 DOS		If documented and supported, providers may use other alternative ICD-10-CM codes, if applicable, such as:	
N17.8	Other acute kidney failure	N18.4	Chronic kidney disease, stage 4 (severe)
N17.9	Acute kidney failure, unspecified	N18.5	Chronic kidney disease, stage 5
Use codes if applicable		N18.6	End stage renal disease

### **Example of Acute Kidney Failure Documentation**

Provider Documented	Coded as Unspecified	Coded with Specificity
A patient is admitted for hypertension and diabetes out of control. The patient is placed in the intensive care unit, administered IV vasodilators, and placed on an IV insulin drip. The patient has acute kidney failure with tubular necrosis, which is resolved with treatment of blood pressure and diabetes. The final diagnosis is stage 3a chronic kidney disease (CKD).	N17.9 – Acute kidney failure, unspecified N18.30 – Chronic kidney disease, stage 3	N18.31 – Chronic kidney disease, stage 3a
