1	Do all pages contain patient identification (ID)?			
2	Are there biographical/personal data?			
3	Is the author identified on each entry?			
4	Are all entries dated?			
5	Is the record legible?			
6	Is there a completed problem list?			
7	Are allergies and adverse reactions to medications prominently displayed?			
8	Is there an appropriate medical history in the record?			
9	Is there documentation of smoking habits and history of alcohol use or substance abuse?			
10	Is there a record of pertinent history and physical examination?			
11	Have lab and other studies been ordered as appropriate?			
12	Are working diagnoses consistent with findings?			
13	Are plans of action/treatment consistent with diagnosis(es)?			
14	Is there a date for return visit or follow-up plan for each encounter?			
15	Have problems from previous visits been addressed?			
16	Is there evidence of appropriate use of consults?			
17	Is there evidence of continuity and coordination of care between primary and specialty providers?			
18	Do consult summaries, labs, and imaging studies reflect primary care provider's review?			
19	Does the care appear to be medically appropriate?			
20	Are preventive services appropriately used?			
21	Is there documentation of prescriptions given, including drug name, dosages, and dates of initial and refill prescriptions?			
22	Is there documentation about <b>Advance Directives</b> (includes Health Care Proxy, Living Wills, DNR)?
